2 (1) Defendant Galleria Park Partners, LLC's Motion for Issue Sanctions, Terminating  
3 Sanctions, and Monetary Sanctions for Failure to Obey Court Orders is denied.

4 (2) As to Defendant's Special Interrogatory numbers 4 and 5, Plaintiff is to provide  
5 Defendant with the bases of its calculations for the amounts of overcharges for electricity as  
6 alleged by Plaintiff for each month and year that Plaintiff alleges it was overcharged by  
7 Defendant for electricity. This includes showing how Plaintiff arrived at the numerical figures  
8 that Plaintiff alleges it was overcharged for each month and year by Defendant for electricity.

9 (3) As to Defendant's Special Interrogatory number 8 and Demand for Production  
10 number 11, Plaintiff is to provide Defendant with its gross receipts broken down on a monthly  
11 basis for each month and year that Plaintiff alleges it was overcharged by Defendant for  
12 electricity.

13 (4) Plaintiff shall serve further responses to Defendant's Special Interrogatory  
14 numbers 4, 5, and 8 and Demand for Production number 11 by the close of business on  
15 October 5, 2016, which is six weeks from the date of the hearing on Defendant Galleria Park  
16 Partners, LLC's Motion for Issue Sanctions, Terminating Sanctions, and Monetary Sanctions for  
17 Failure to Obey Court Orders.

18 (5) Defendant is to give notice.


